

Searching online encyclopedias.

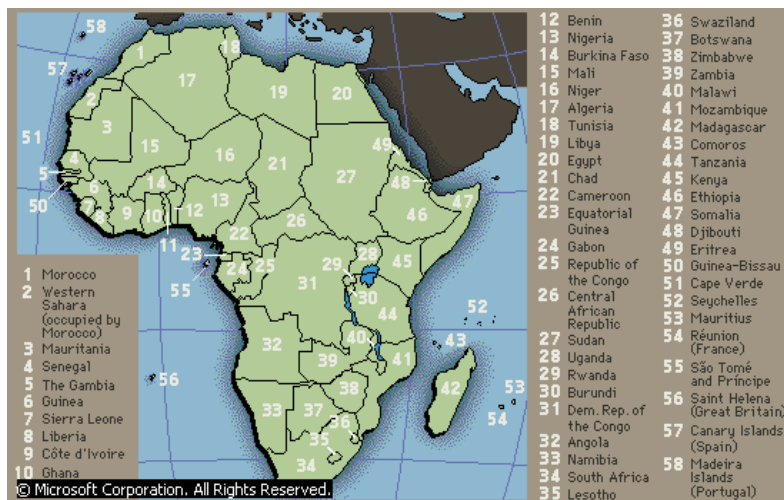
